## G. COMPREHENSIVE EXAMS

At the end of course work, comprehensive qualifying exams are required. These exams should normally occur no later than the 5th semester following Ph.D. program admission. While preparing for the exams and while working on a dissertation proposal, the student may enroll in predoctoral research, CCJ7979, Advanced Research. All students will be required to take two comprehensive examinations. The first exam is a tool exam in methods and statistics. This exam will require the student to demonstrate proficiency in the application of methodological/statistical techniques to the study of criminology and law, broadly speaking. Depending on the area of specialization, students will be required to possess a mastery of knowledge within either the (1) Crime and Justice or (2) Law and Society area. The second exam is an area exam in the students chosen area of specialization. Both exams are administered and graded by appointed committees.
